

COVID-19 Contact Tracing

Your actions make all of us safer. Local Health Departments are here to help us slow the spread of COVID-19 to keep you, your family, and your community safe.

If you have COVID-19



Your Local Health Department will call to let you know you've been exposed to COVID-19



You should call the people you have recently been in contact with



They will ask you to stay home to self-isolate and offer resources, if needed. See [here](#) for more patient guidance

If you have been around someone with COVID-19



Your Local Health Department or someone you have been around recently will let you know that you've been exposed to COVID-19



You will be asked to watch your symptoms and let your Local Health Department know if you have new symptoms



They will ask you to stay at home and self-quarantine for 14, 10, or 7 days depending on your circumstances. See [here](#) for more quarantine guidance
